## 3. The genitive construction

٣) أَلْإِضَافَةُ

A noun cannot only be modified by an adjective, but also by a following noun in the genitive. The two nouns form a compound phrase called أُلْمُضَافُ (genitive construction) with الْمُضَافُ (annexed or 1st part of the construction) and اللهُضَافُ إِلَيْهِ (attribute or 2nd part of the construction). أَلْمُضَافُ إِلَيْهِ is always without an article and without nunation in the case required by the function of the noun. If اللهُضَافُ إِلَيْهِ is definite, اللهُضَافُ إِلَيْهِ is considered definite too and if اللهُضَافُ إِلَيْهِ is considered indefinite as well.
